Cooperation in public administration

Summary

The text shows in monographic way the crucial internal relation which happens between public administration bodies - cooperation in public administration. The thesis is divided into two parts. The first one - theoretical - focuses on basic legal issues connected with the institution of cooperation in public administration in general.

The second part of the thesis concerns the cooperation in administrative practice. Initially, the concepts of 'type' and 'form' of cooperation was explained.

In the following chapters of the thesis an analysis of the cooperation in administrative constitutional, substantive and procedural law is performed.

Administrative constitutional law is discussed in the sixth chapter, which consists of the administrative bodies contract, local government unions, local government associations, authorization to act on behalf of the authority, international forms of local governments cooperation and cooperation of independent regulatory authorities.

The seventh chapter describes the core of the institution of cooperation in Polish administrative law - the administrative cooperation in substantive law, which is expression of the position on the draft act by the cooperating body. In the chapter, subjects, the most important forms, legal basis and examples of this cooperation is discussed.

The eighth (which is the last) chapter consists of the considerations about procedural layer of cooperation included in the Polish Code of Administrative Proceedings. In the chapter, the subject of the analysis is also the amendment of the Code enacted in 2017, considering administrative cooperation as the general rule of administrative proceedings, European Administrative Cooperation and the other forms of cooperation of the authorities during administrative proceedings.
